1. ENTRIES: Pre-registration is encouraged.

2. FEES:

- a) \$10.00 per regular class or \$50.00 for unlimited classes per horse/handler for this day. Stake Classes \$25 and are not included in day fee. *Day Fee applies to pre-entry only (received prior to August 9)*

3. EQUINES: Age of equine shall be that reached during the calendar year 2024. Junior horse is defined as age 3 – 5 of the current calendar year. All equines welcome! Stallions/Jacks not to be handled by anyone under 18 and must be in a chain and under control at all times. If this is not the case, they will be asked to leave the premises with no refund.

4. EXHIBITORS:

- a) Age as of January 1, 2024
The same animal can be shown by different handlers in different age categories.
- b) NO DOGS.
- c) No bleachers, bring your own lawn chairs.

5. HELMETS: Are encouraged and will never be penalized. All youth exhibitors (under age

18) must have properly fitted and certified helmets on when riding or working with livestock.

6. RULES:

- a) Have FUN and be SAFE
- b) Westlock Ag Society, the Show Committee and the Board of Directors will not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to persons, equine, or property at this show.
- c) All classes are at the decision of the Judge. Some classes may be combined or split based on participation numbers.
- d) Show clothes are encouraged but not required. Training equipment not allowed. 1 hand on a shank bit in western classes.
- e) No cross entry between walk trot and regular classes.

7. DESCRIPTIONS:

- a) HALTER CLASSES – Competitors may show more than one horse in a class provided they have people to hold the other horses.
- b) SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES – Patterns will be posted online at least a week before show date and at the show office day of the show.
- c) SPORTHORSE HALTER – To be judged on suitability of horse to English-type riding.
- d) STOCK HORSE HALTER – To be judged on suitability of horse to Western-type riding.
- e) PLEASURE CLASSES – English and Western, each entry will be judged according to riding style and breed standard.
- f) STAKE CLASSES – \$25 to enter each class (in addition to day fee, if applicable.) Pay out at 50/30/20.
- g) EQUITATION – English and Western, patterns will be posted online at least a week prior to show date and at the show office day of the show.
- h) ON COMMAND – All ages. Instruction will be given before the class starts.

8. PRIZES

- a) Rosettes to 5th place will be awarded
- b) Cash back top 3: First \$20, Second: \$10, Third: \$5.
- c) Championship halters will be awarded to High Point Senior and High Point Junior riders. Points accrued based on class placings. No points or money for lead line.

HOBBY HORSE MINI SHOW!

A Hobby Horse is defined as a crafted horse head attached to a stick or other material that can be carried or worn at waist level. For example: a unicorn pool floatie, a stick horse, a box worn with suspenders, etc.

The perfect way for the horse-crazy kid to get involved in showing without diving into horse ownership! Kids (big and small!) are encouraged to bring their own hobby horse into the ring to be judged like a real horse show. Hobby horses can be homemade or purchased from a retailer. Your imagination is the only limit!
